

Travel Protocol

If you are flying:

An additional fee of \$100 will be applied to your final invoice to be picked up and dropped off at the airport.

Book a flight to Spokane International Airport in Spokane, Washington on the Saturday before your hunt.

Pick-Up is at the Ramada Inn on Sunday Morning between 10am - 11am

Drop off is at the Spokane International Airport on Sunday Morning between 9am-10am for all Fall Hunts and on Saturday Morning between 9am-10am for Spring Hunts.

We recommend, because the weather can be so unpredictable, that you book an afternoon or evening flight.

There will be a \$200 charge for an earlier or later pick up/ drop off.

We do not provide travel to and from the airport for Spring Turkey hunts or Mountain Lion Hunts

If you choose to book a hotel room at another location in Spokane Washington, you must meet us at the Ramada Inn at 10am Sunday morning.

We do not pick-up at any other locations.

If you are driving:

The lodge will be open to receive you and your luggage at 2:00pm

If you will be arriving early, please let us know as soon as possible so that we can accommodate a parking arrangement for your vehicle(s).

The lodge will not be open for luggage and belongings to be unpacked until 2:00pm.

Sunday Schedule:

You will arrive at the lodge at 2pm. After your rooms are assigned and your luggage is unpacked, guides will take you to a range to shoot in and test your bows and/or rifles.

A 3D Range is set up during archery season for your entertainment. Please bring field tips to be able to enjoy the range.

Dinner will be served at 6pm.

Directly after dinner we will pair you with your guide. This time will be used to get a plan together for your hunt.

Hunter Orientation will follow. The Orientation will be a 20-minute meeting to go over all the laws, rules, regulations, and any questions you may have about your hunt.

Extra Information

- **Shipping your gear is an option. Some clients prefer to have their archery and rifle equipment shipped to us (you cannot ship your gun). We recommend using FedEx or UPS with tracking information. Let Morgan know ahead of time the ETA of your gear and once it arrives it will be kept in a locked room, untouched, until your arrival.**
- **If you are driving, we recommend that you bring your own coolers or freezers. We are situated in a very small town with limited access to high quantities of coolers, ice or dry ice. If your vehicle allows it, we have seen clients come with small freezers that we are able to plug in until the time of your departure. If you are flying you may have coolers shipped to the lodge.**
- **We try to keep lodging necessities available in case you forget anything. We ask that you bring toiletries, shampoo, soap, laundry detergent with you. Bedding, pillows, and towels are provided. Laundry service is included in your stay.**
- **Alcohol is not prohibited but it is also not provided. There will be a fridge available to all hunters in camp to use for any alcoholic beverages and snacks you bring for yourself.**
- **We have boot dryers available for you to use at the lodge.**
- **Pack a set of lodge shoes such as crocs or slippers to wear inside the dining area**
- **If you are bringing a youth hunter I will provide you with the information to apply soon.**
